COMMISSIONER'S ORDER

WHEREAS, in the County of Lee beginning on the 20th day of March, 2020, the County Judge issued a Declaration of Local Disaster as a result of the COVID-19 Coronavirus, and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to spread and to pose and increasing, imminent threat of disaster throughout Texas, and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108 (b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF LEE COUNTY, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, in the County of Lee beginning on the 23rd day of March, 2020, there is the imminent

- 1. That the state of declaration proclaimed for Lee County by the Lee County Judge on March 20, 2020 shall continue.
- 2. Lee County Commissioners authorize the County Judge to determine that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Lee County no longer create a public safety hazard created by the COVID-19.
- 3. This Order is passed as an emergency measure pursuant to the Government Code and shall become effective as of this date.
